



# 2016 Recycle calendar

Recycle collection days for curbside customers

This flyer lists recycling pickup dates and information for 2016. Keep the collection schedule on the back page handy for future reference. You can also download this flyer at [www.ThurstonSolidWaste.org/Resources](http://www.ThurstonSolidWaste.org/Resources).

## Cart placement

Put your cart out by 6 a.m. on pickup days. Place at the curb or within 3 feet of the driving surface of the road or lane, with the opening of the cart facing the street or alley. Your cart should be at least 5 feet away from basketball hoops, trees, mailboxes, or other containers. Make sure cart is 5 feet away from vehicles. Allow 18 feet of space above the cart to make room for the truck's robotic arm.



## Recycle right

Recycling is a great way to reduce trash disposal costs, conserve resources, and cut down on the amount of waste going to the landfill. Do YOUR part and recycle the right way – it's easy!

- Rinse any food from containers.
- Put glass in a separate container.
- Keep items loose in the cart - not in bags.
- Remember - plastic bags **DON'T** go in your curbside recycle cart.

## Recycle glass correctly

Put glass in a separate, rigid container between 5 and 20 gallons in size. Remember to drill enough drain holes in the bottom – if rainwater collects in your container, the driver cannot take your glass. Glass is collected every other recycle day and you can set out more than one container.

**RECYCLE is picked up every TWO weeks.**

 If you are an "A," set out your recycle cart on ALL yellow weeks.

 If you are a "B," set out your recycle cart on ALL blue weeks.

**GLASS is picked up every FOUR weeks alongside the recycle cart.**

**A1** - set glass out A1 weeks.

**A2** - set glass out A2 weeks.

**B1** - set glass out B1 weeks.

**B2** - set glass out B2 weeks.

\* If your account begins with 2183 — Routes will be delayed one day due to holiday.
